

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 17 OF THE VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE,
MINNESOTA, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING GENERAL DRAYING AND OPERATION
OF BILLIARD AND POOL HALLS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake do ordain as follows:

Section 2.- All persons, firms or corporations conducting or desiring to conduct a billiard or pool hall within the Village limits, shall first obtain from the Village Council a license so to do, and shall pay to said Village therefor the sum of five (\$5.00) dollars for each and every billiard or pool table for a period of one year, or fraction thereof, from May 1st, which shall be payable in advance.

Section 2:-

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
