

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF WEST ROAD
IN THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE, MINNESOTA, TO FOLZ BOULEVARD


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Moose Lake is desirous of recognizing the many years of dedicated and unselfish public service of one of its favorite sons, former Mayor Clarence Folz;

The City Council of the City of Moose Lake does ordain as follows:

Section One. That the name of that certain street in the City of Moose Lake, Minnesota, now known and designated as WEST ROAD, as the same extends through the City of Moose Lake, from its intersection or junction with Arrowhead Lane, and extending West to the City Limits, shall be changed and renamed FOLZ BOULEVARD, and shall hereafter be known and designated as FOLZ BOULEVARD.


Section Two. That that part of Ordinance #41 inconsistent with Section One, above, is hereby repealed.
