

ORDINANCE NO. 104-C
City of Moose Lake, Minnesota

**AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE CITY'S ZONING CONTROLS
TO ANNEXED TERRITORIES**

The City Council of the City of Moose Lake, Minnesota hereby ordains:

Sec. 1.01 Purpose. The purpose of this section is to promote the health, safety and general welfare of the public and to protect and preserve property values by extending the City's zoning map and zoning controls to annexed territories.

Sec. 2.01 The parcel of land legally described as follows, to wit:

Southeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter, Section 29, Township 46, North of Range 19 West of the Fourth Principal Meridian. Subject to any and all public roads and rights of way.

is hereby designated a **C-2 General Commercial District** under the City of Moose Lake's Zoning Ordinance No. 104, Article XII.

Sec. 3.01 The parcel of land legally described as follows, to wit:

Government Lot 5 and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 46, Range 19, Carlton County, Minnesota.

AND ALSO

Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 22, Township 46, Range 19, Carlton County, Minnesota, which lies westerly of the westerly right of way Interstate Highway No. 35.

AND ALSO

Those parts of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter Section 27, Township 46, Range 19, Carlton County, Minnesota, which lies westerly of the westerly right of way of Interstate Highway No. 35.

AND ALSO

The Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter Section 28, Township 46, Range 19, Carlton County, Minnesota.

is hereby designated a **P-1 Parks, Schools and Related District** under the City of Moose Lake's Zoning Ordinance No. 104, Article XVI. It shall also be subject to the Shoreland Ordinance provisions of Article IV of the City of Moose Lake's Zoning Ordinance No. 104.

Sec. 4.01. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and remain in full force from and after its passage and publication and upon the approval of the Joint Resolution of Orderly Annexation of the aforescribed parcels by the Director of the Minnesota Boundary Authority, Office of Administrative Hearings, State of Minnesota.


